

INTERNATIONAL CALL FOR TENDERS

(No.: 2021/G/11)

The Tunisian Electricity and Gas Company (STEG) proposes to launch an International Call for Tenders, in two lots, for:

- Construction of the gas compressor station of Ain Turkia, Governorate of Sfax (Lot n°1).
- Reinforcement of the M'saken gas compressor station, Governorate of Sousse (Lot n°2).

Funding: This project is funded by the Kuwait Fund for Arab Economic Development: FKDEA.

Conditions of participation:

Only bidders can participate in this call for tenders:

- * Registered on the TUNEPS system and having the electronic signature certificate (www.tuneps.tn),
- * Having the status of natural or legal person and:
 - With an ISO9001 certificate in the areas recommended by the specifications, currently valid.
 - Having, in addition for local bidders, a VRD2 Cat5 approval or, a B0 Cat4 approval or more, currently valid.
- Justifying sufficient financial and technical references and this, by providing in its offer, the documents required by the specifications.

Bid bank guarantees in the amount of:

- Eighty Thousand Dinars (80,000 DT) for lot n°1,
- Thirty Thousand Dinars (30,000DT) for lot n°2.

Tenders (technical and financial) must be sent online via TUNEPS unless the TUNEPS system is technically incapable (file size). If necessary, part of the offer may be sent offline provided that it is mentioned beforehand in the offer sent online.

The off-line part of the offer must reach STEG in a sealed envelope bearing the number of the call for tenders and its subject and the words “do not open” and this, by registered mail or by express post or delivered directly at the STEG Central Order Office; 38, Rue Kamel ATATURK- 1080 Tunis (Counter discharge), at the latest, Wednesday March 09, 2022 at 9:00 a.m., strict deadline in the name of:

The part of the offline offer received after the deadline for receipt of offers will be considered null and void. The date of dispatch or the postmark will not be taken into account for the acceptance of offers, only the stamp of the Central Order Office of STEG is authentic.

However, all financial documents as well as any element relating to the technical and financial evaluation must be sent online via TUNEPS.

The specifications are available on the TUNEPS system, free of charge.

The opening session of the technical and financial offers is public and will take place on Wednesday March 09, 2022 from 9:30 a.m. at the STEG head office, 38 Rue Kemal Ataturk, Tunis, Building G, 3rd floor.

The representative of the tenderer must be provided with a mandate of representation bearing the name of the agent and the identity document.

Tenders will remain valid for 120 days from the day after the deadline for receipt of tenders.
