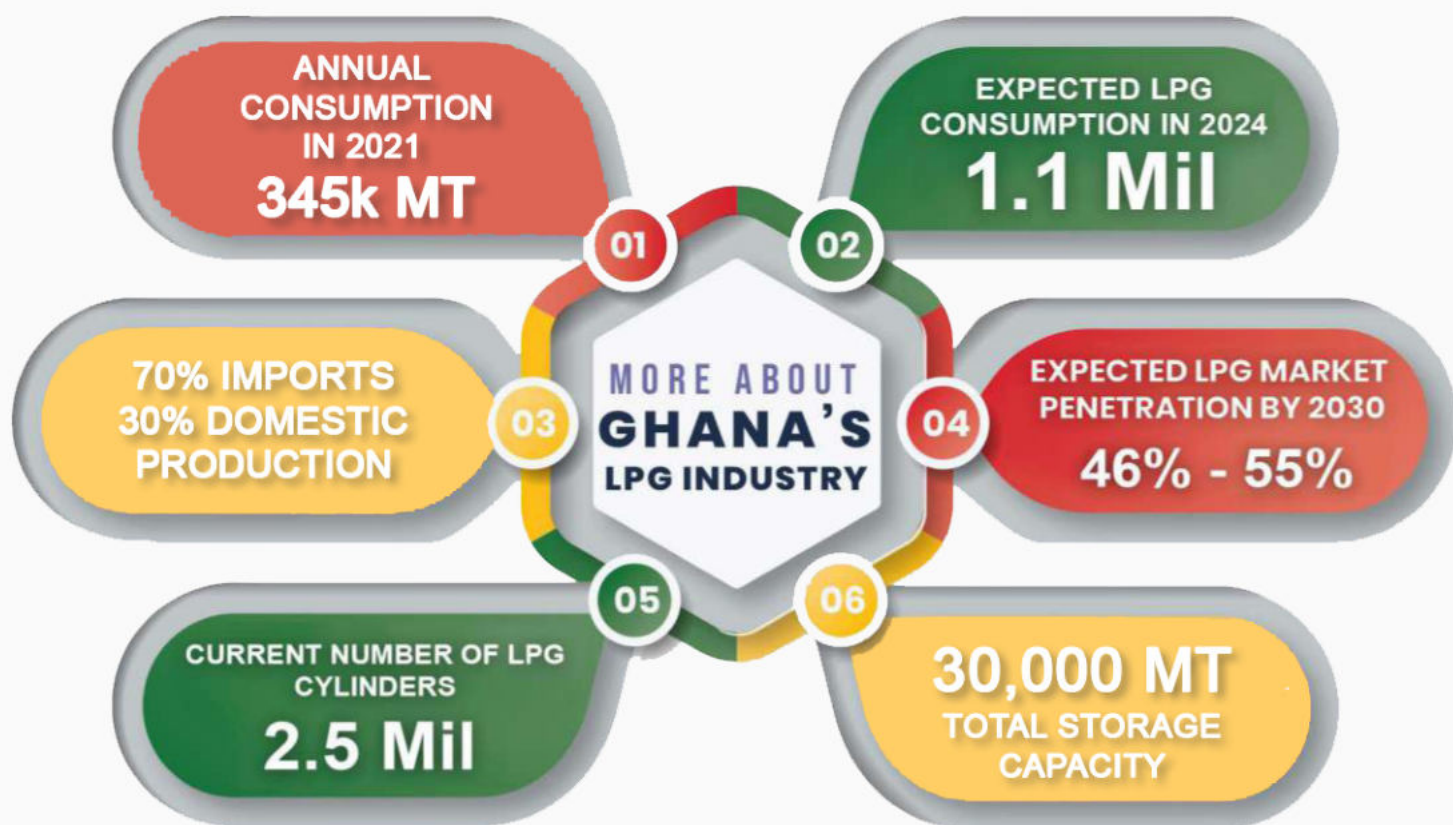


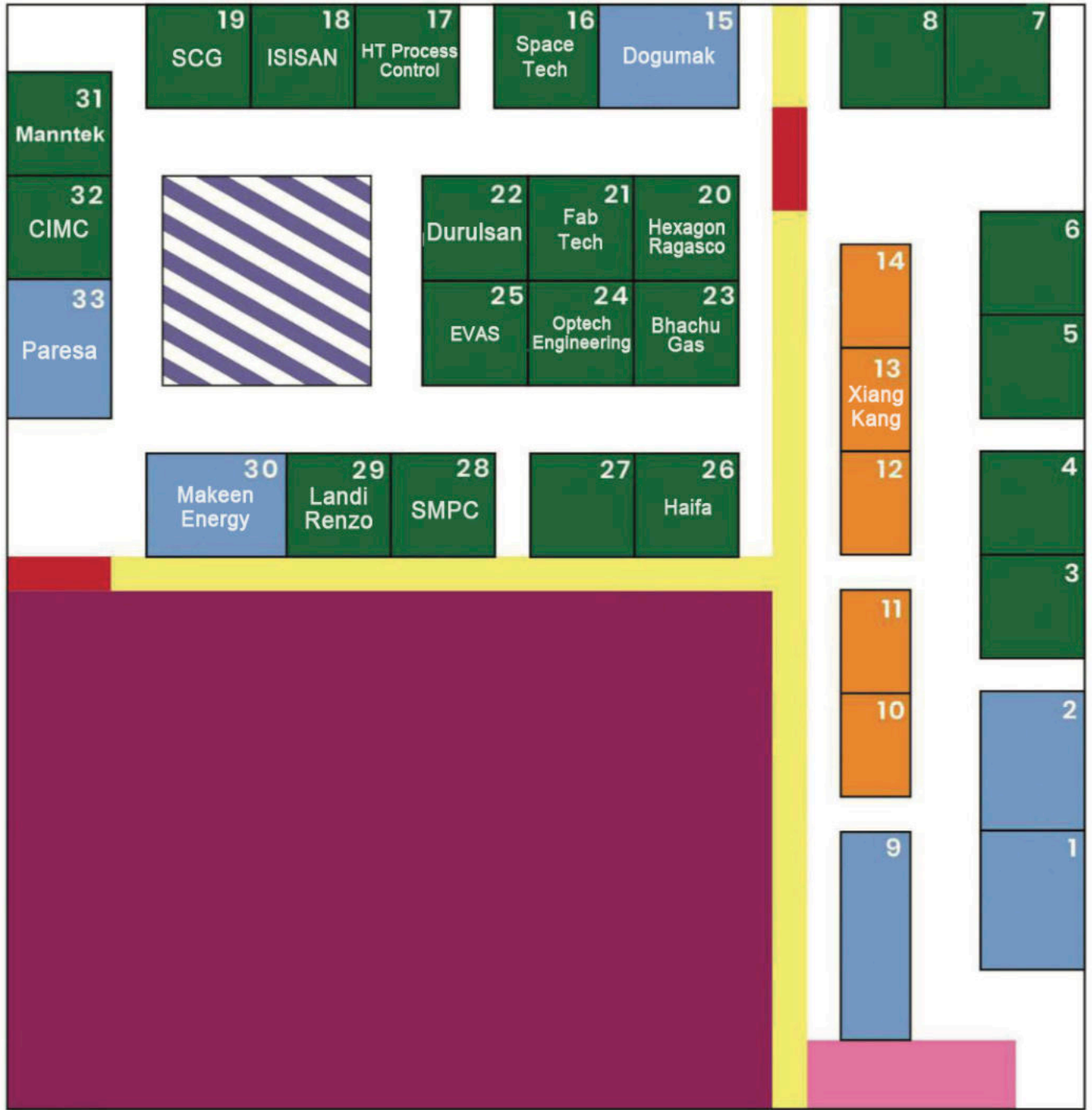
ABOUT 3RD WEST AFRICA LPG Expo
